Talouden, kulttuurin ja yhteiskunnan kehitystä selitetään fysiikasta lähtien ja evoluutiolla täydentäen. Osansa saavat myös muun muassa fyysikaalisen maailmankuvan filosofinen ulottuvuus ja vertailu muihin selitysmalleihin.
