The statement above explains the reason why the term Electronic Commerce has kept both business research and business practice as occupied as barely any other term, in the last years.5 Warren D. Furthermore, as customers will demand and tolerate only delighting buying experiences, it is a necessity to capture and analyze information about buying behavior in the 21st century business.⁸ When talking about E-Commerce, which is a part of Electronic Business (E-Business), describing the sale of goods and services via the Internet targeting a mass market⁹, the following two areas have to be differentiated: Business-to-Customer (B2C) E-Commerce, meaning the settlement of buying contracts between a customer and a business.
